Dates	Which Assessments/Tests?
Fall Testing Window: September 18-Oct 13, 2017	All Tier I "first look" assessments will be administered/ finished by Sept 29), and all "second look" assessments will be finished by Oct 13). Second-look assessments administered by Interventionists/special educators will be entered by Interventionists/special educators, and reviewed with classroom teachers at a team meeting.
Oct 18, 2017	All Tier I paper/pencil assessment results have been entered into Alpine by the classroom teacher..
Oct 16, 17 (two days) K-6 Writing On-Demand assessment	Fall writing assessment given to students K-6 by teachers. Results will be co- scored by teachers in grades K-6 on Oct 19 inservice . Results will be entered into Alpine by classroom teachers by Nov 2.
By October 25, 2017	First round of assessment data will be reviewed by buildings, during a faculty meeting, as per direction of building principals. State SBAC data also will be available for review within Alpine
Winter Testing Window: January 2--Jan 19, for "first look" assessments, and from Jan 19-Feb 2 for "second look."	All Tier I "first look" assessments will be readministered (and finished by January 19). All "second look" assessments need to be completed by Feb 2 . Second look assessments can actually be completed earlier than Feb 1st, once first-look assessments are completed.
February 9, 2018	All Tier I paper/pencil assessment results have been entered into Alpine by the classroom teacher. Second-look assessments given by interventionists/special educators (PNOA, BV, F/P, phonological awareness) will be entered into Alpine by Interventionists/special educators, and reviewed asap with classroom teachers at a team meeting.
By February 16, 2018	Second round of assessment data will be reviewed by buildings, as per direction of building principals.
March 26,27, 2018 (two days) K-6 Writing On Demand assessment	K-6 Writing Assessment given to students in K-6 by all teachers. Results will be co-scored by all teachers in grades K-6 on March 30 inservice .
SBAC testing window, grades 3-9 (March 12-May 25, 2018) Make-up testing window May 29-June 12, 2018	Each school's specific schedule will be developed and coordinated with building principals and/or in-house test coordinators, and each building's in-house school schedule will be published by February 16, along with accommodation locations/staff (by principals), and plans for coverage by certified administrators in case of staff absences during testing times. All certifications for test administration (all staff who will be administering the test) need to be completed Feb 14, and certifications will be collected by principals by Feb 16. Time during faculty meeting will be scheduled for certification. Note: SBAC has changed at the HS level to be given to 9th grade, rather than 11th grade, starting in 2018.
<u>New Science NGSS field testing</u> grades 5, 8,11; dates to be announced by AOE.	The State will be announcing the timeline for this. It will be computer administered. More information will be coming out about this. This should be coordinated by building principals and/or test coordinators, with a schedule to be published to all building staff and to parents at least 30 days in advance. For staff, in-house accommodation locations/staff (by principals), and plans for coverage by certified administrators in case of staff absences during testing times, will also be shared.
NAEP: 4, 8, 11	Not happening in 2018, since administered in 2017.

<p>Spring Testing Window: April 30-June 1)</p>	<p>All Tier I “first look” assessments will be readministered starting April 30 (and finished by May 18). All “second look” assessments need to be completed by June 1 (or eight school days prior to the last day of school, in case of snow days). Second-look assessments can actually be completed earlier than May 18th, once first-look assessments are completed.</p>
<p>June 6 (or five school days prior to last day of school, in case of snow days)</p>	<p>All Tier I paper/pencil assessment results have been entered into Alpine.</p>
<p>June 15 (or last day of school)</p>	<p>All Tier I assessments concluded and confirmed via signout sheets to principals.</p>
